
Whitsunday Funerals & Crematorium provide this book to not only keep the mind and hands busy but to ensure that we stay committed to our community service program.







Definitions of Services

Direct Cremation

Direct Cremation is where a person who has passed is brought into our care from a Nursing Home, Hospital or Residence etc. We then prepare the person in the clothes provided and place them into a direct cremation coffin. They are then taken for cremation & ashes are returned to the family in a cremation travel urn. A Death Certificate is issued after completing necessary documents. **this applies for non coronial cases**

Memorial Service

Memorial Service has the same process as a Direct Cremation, however with the addition of having a Memorial Service (after the cremation has occurred) with the Ashes (instead of a coffin being present). This includes music, flowers **\$150**, celebrant / clergy **\$300**, use of our chapel or home residence, memorial book (signing book), orders of service **40 printed** and all appropriate paperwork.

Cremation Funeral Service

Cremation Funeral Service includes all of the above mentioned in a Memorial Service with the addition of a coffin (selected by the family) present at the Service, and the cremation is completed after the service has been completed.

Burial Funeral Service

Burial Funeral Service has all the details and inclusions of a Cremation Service, with the obvious change from a Cremation to a Burial. Council fees do increase each year and can be provided to you upon request. Most Burial Services are completed at 11:00am due to overtime charges that can be applied if the Funeral runs over the Council's Cemetery operating hours.

this charge is charged by the council This is why you see most services being held at 11:00am or earlier and due to the increase in temperatures of an afternoon.

** However you can most certainly hold a service at 1:00pm or 2:00pm, we just like to be transparent in other charges that may apply if the designated times are exceeded by council.** Other charges that may apply are if the council is forced to hand dig the grave rather than use a machine to dig the grave. You will be made aware of this at time of arrangement should the hand dig be required.

All of our fees that are charged to you as cash disbursements (payments to council, florists, newspapers will be provided to you upon request, please just ask and we will send them through to you. This ensures that you know that no extra charges have been inflated.






